

Guidelines on Ensuring Information Quality -- Solicitation of Pul Comments

- Agency: Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

- **Summary:** The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is requesting comments from members of the public and interest groups on its draft Information Quality (IQ) Guidelines. Focus questions have been increase public feedback. The IQ Guidelines contain the Commission's policy and procedures for quality of agency information before it is disseminated to the public. They also contain the proce which an affected person may obtain correction of information that does not comply with the IQ The Commission will consider comments received in response to this notice in developing its fina Guidelines.
