National Science Foundation DRAFT Information Quality Guidelines

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) issued government-wide guidelines under section 515 of the Treasury and General Government Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2001 (Public Law 106-554) to ensure and maximize the quality, objectivity, utility and integrity of information disseminated by Federal agencies. OMB's guidelines were published in the *Federal Register* in Volume 66, No. 189 on Friday, September 28, 2001, and updated in Volume 2, No. 67 on Thursday, January 3, 2002. A corrected version of the guidelines was published in the *Federal Register* in Volume 67, No. 36 on February 22, 2002. Each Federal agency is responsible for issuing its own section 515 guidelines. As a result, The National Science Foundation has developed corresponding DRAFT information quality guidelines.

The following document provides the DRAFT National Science Foundation Information Quality Guidelines.
