# **Submitting Comments on RRB's Draft Section 515 Guidelines**

## OMB section 515 information quality guidelines: Background

Section 515 of the Treasury and General Government Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2001 (Public Law 106-554) directs the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to issue government-wide guidelines for Federal agencies to ensure and maximize the quality, objectivity, utility and integrity of information disseminated by Federal agencies. In response, OMB issued government-

wide guidelines 61 FR 8452 (February 22, 2002) requiring Federal agencies that are subject to the Paperwork Reduction Act (44 U.S.C. chapter 35) to develop and publish their own information quality guidelines and provide the public with administrative means for requesting corrections of information subject to the guidelines.

#### We will:

- Consider all comments received by June 15, 2002 in response to this notice
- Develop proposed final RRB section 515 guidelines and procedures for submission to OMB by July 1, 2002
- Publish a Notice of our final guidelines and correction procedures in the Federal Register and make them available at the web address mentioned above no later than October 1, 2002.
